## Parliamentary Briefing

# Marine and Coastal Access Bill Amendment

### Regulation of nets and other fishing gear (Clause 186)

The organisations listed above are closely engaged in the Marine & Coastal Access Bill. We are also members of Wildlife and Countryside Link's Marine Task Force<sup>1</sup>, which has been campaigning for several years for improvements in marine conservation.

#### Background

Section 3 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967 is the provision allowing control of the kinds of fishing gear used. This is a welcome power and it has been used to good effect. Clause 186 of the Marine and Coastal Access Bill updates it somewhat, and we suggest that it could be improved in two further ways.

The first of these is a point that we have also made in a separate proposed amendment to clause 152 – IFCA byelaw making powers – in relation to IFCA (as opposed to Government) powers to regulate fishing gear. We believe that there ought to be a power to require the use of best available technologies designed to deter (prevent or reduce) by-catch.

The second improvement is to clarify that the power to control gears can indeed be used for marine environmental purposes (as opposed to the protection of undersized quarry species). Both amendments are shown in the Annex, below.
